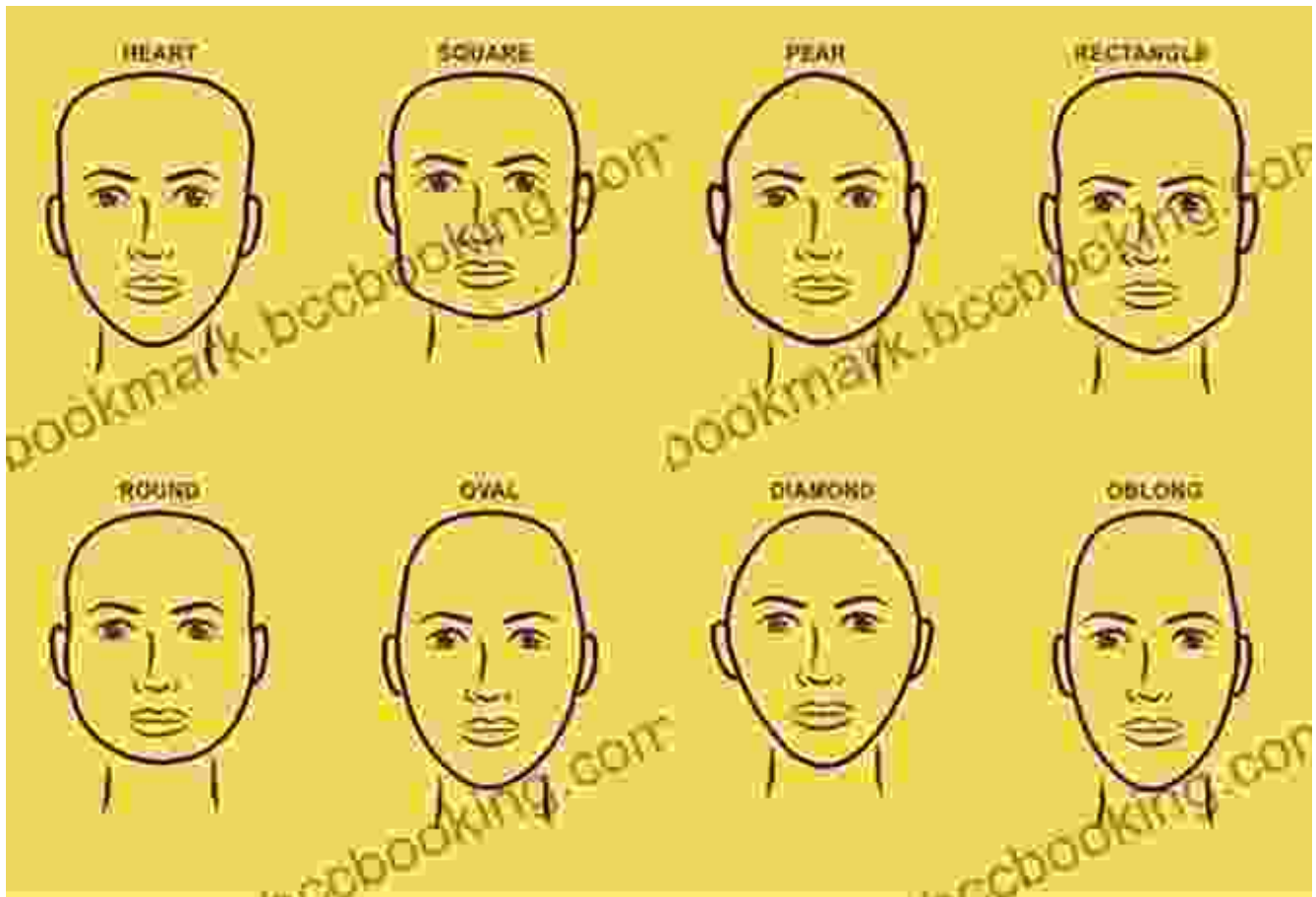

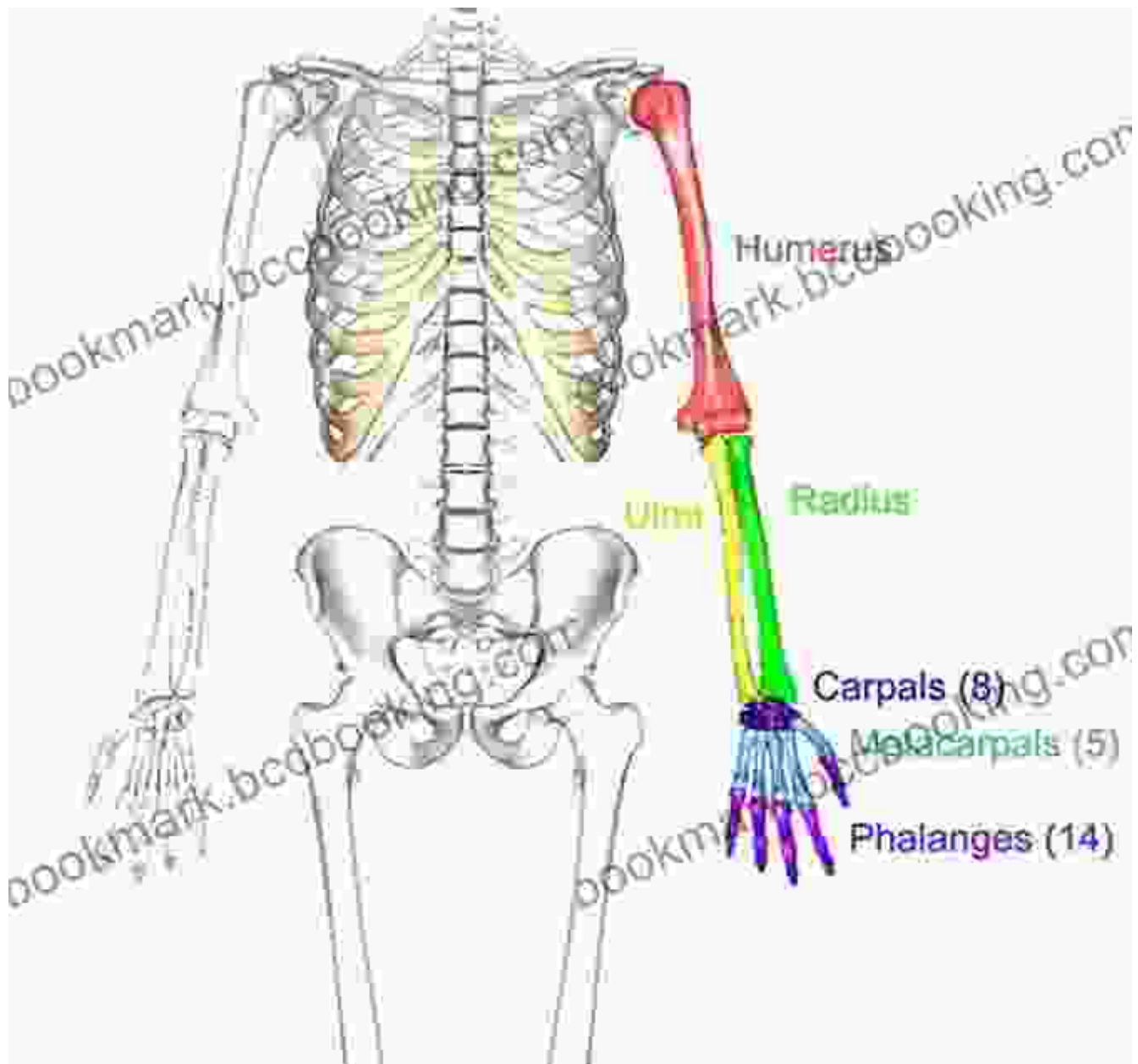
## Drawing a Crewmate

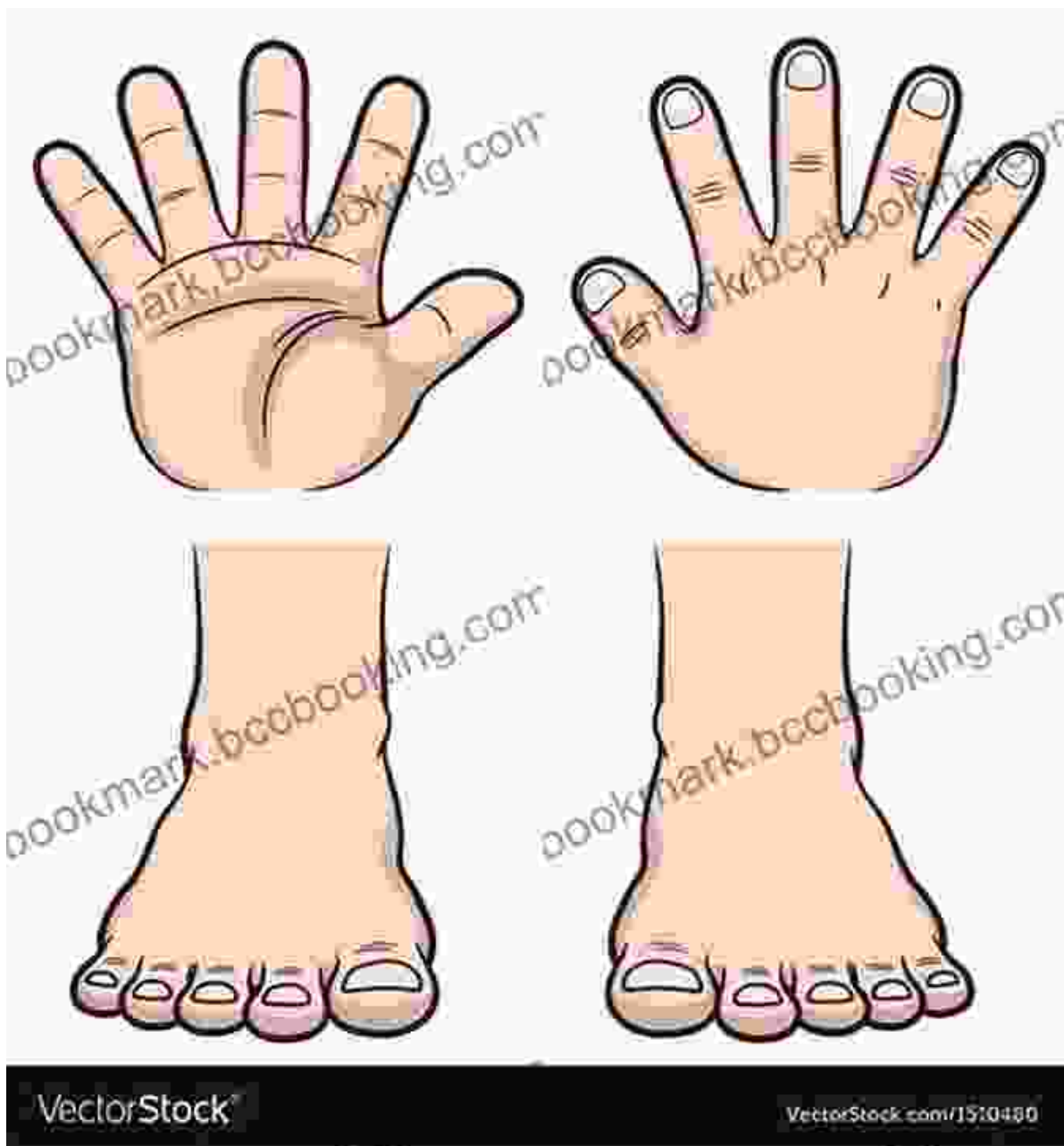

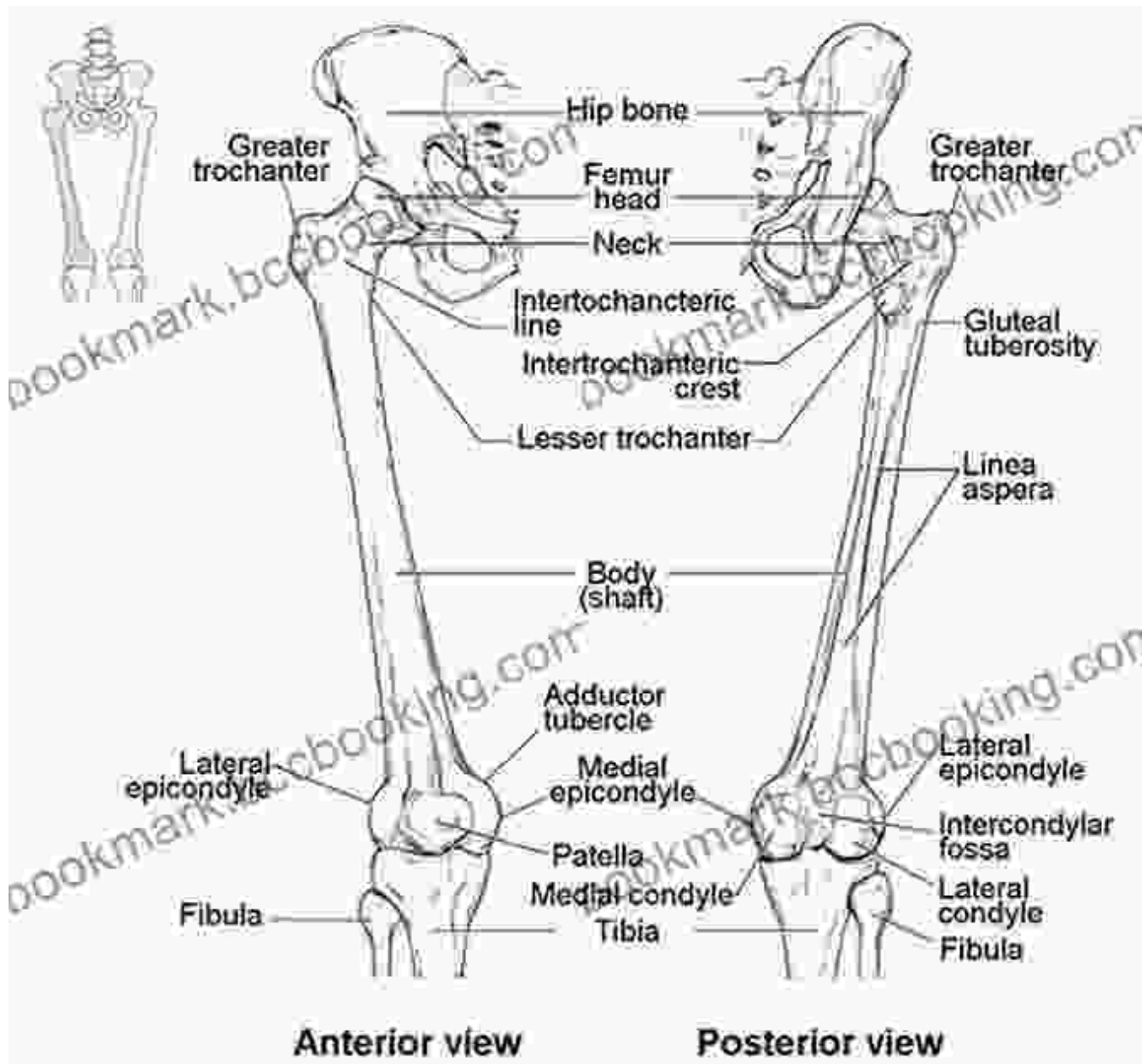
## **Drawing an Imposter**

Draw a curved line for the body, wider at the bottom than at the top. Connect the head to the body with a short neck. Next, draw four lines for the limbs: two arms and two legs.

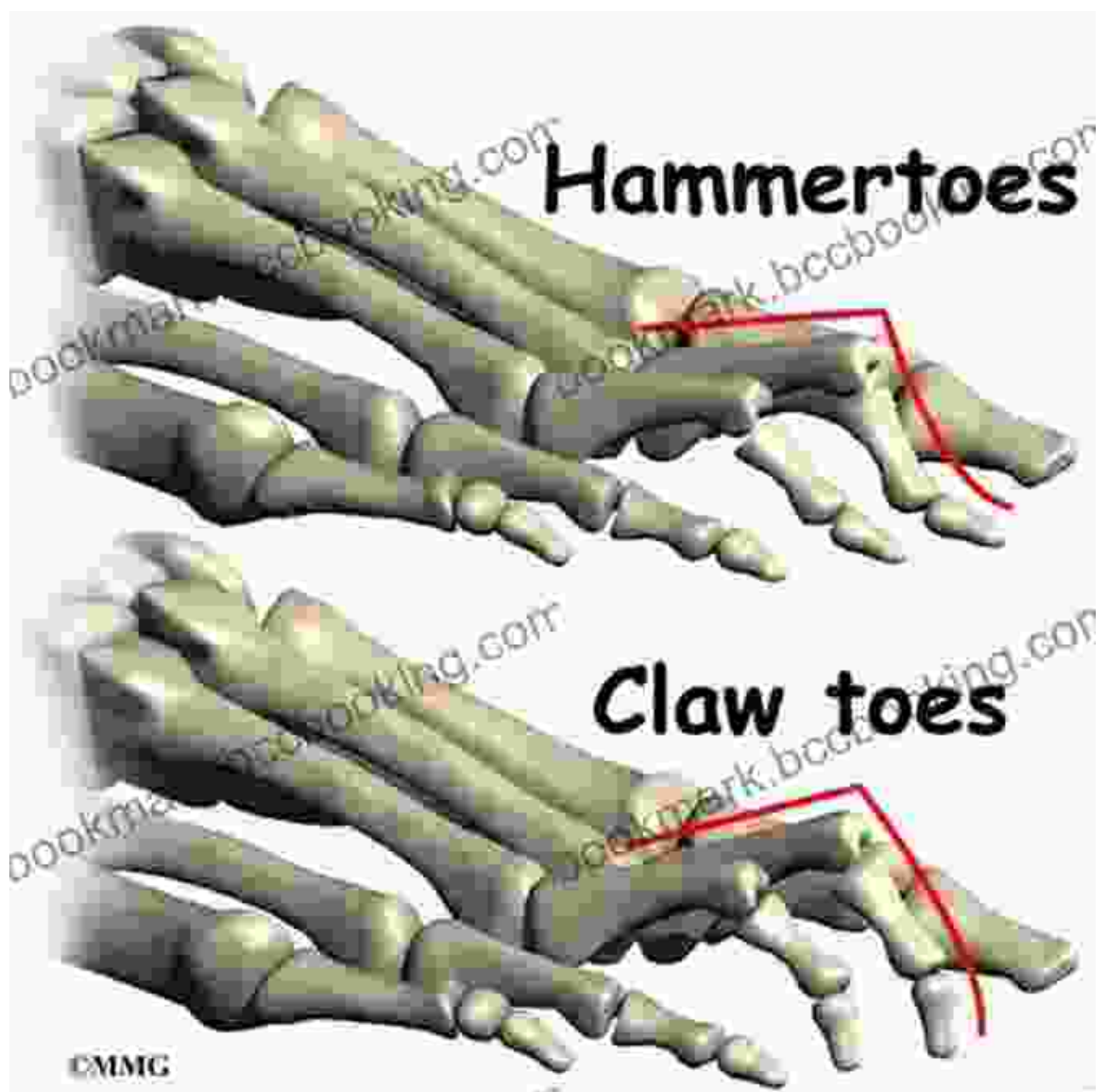
**Step 3: Add Eyes, Mouth, and Teeth**

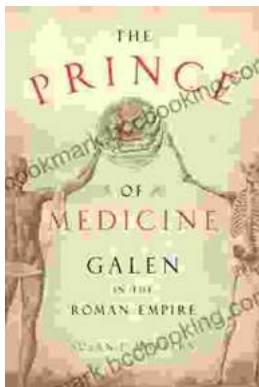
