 <p>#1 Voluntary Vaccination MCOSD provides COVID-19 vaccinations. No health insurance required, they are available for ages 12 and up through the Department of Health (DOH), pediatricians, and pharmacists. The CDC and DOH advise that the COVID-19 vaccine is the best, long-term way to fight against the virus.</p>	<p>#2 Staff/Student Health - Stay Home When Sick To help protect your child's health and the health of those around them, encourage your child to stay home when they are ill. If you are a family member in the home, encourage a COVID test result. DOH requires all vaccinated students in the household to stay home.</p> 
 <p>#3 Hand Hygiene The best way staff and students to protect their health is the practice of frequent hand washing. Hand sanitizer will be made available at District-operated sites. Parents may send sanitizer into school with their child.</p>	<p>#4 Face Coverings - Masks are Voluntary The Martin County School Board has voted to make masks optional for students and staff during the 2021/2022 school year. In the event of an unusually high spike in cases or change in pandemic circumstances, the School Board may adjust this protocol as necessary. Masks will be available for students and staff at each site for those who choose to wear one.</p> 
 <p>#5 Screening/Temperature Checks Screening with non-contact thermometers MAY be required at some entering district sites. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry. Training related to the identification of COVID-19 symptoms is provided for staff to assist in the monitoring of employee and student health.</p>	<p>#6 Facility Health - Cleaning, Disinfecting, and Ventilation Surfaces are cleaned and disinfected frequently with EPA-registered disinfectant products that are appropriate for use by staff for all high-touch surfaces in areas. Facilities have been confirmed with MERV filters for enhanced filtration.</p> 
 <p>#7 Social Distancing Layouts Social distancing MAY be implemented when possible. Seating charts will continue to be required for classrooms and bus transportation. Seating charts may be required for activities if needed.</p>	<p>#8 Indoor Communal Spaces Events MAY require limited occupancy based on the type of activity and the expected number of attendees. All indoor spaces are cleaned and disinfected frequently.</p> 
 <p>#9 Gatherings and Field Trips Outside events continue to be permitted whenever possible. Field trips will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis through the Office of Risk Management.</p>	<p>#10 Higher Risk for Illness Staff and students at high risk for illness may have their specific circumstances evaluated by the District Office of Human Resources/Occupational Safety and Health or Exceptional Student Education as needed.</p> 

In August 2021, the District will make a full return to traditional in-person learning, with no remote option. All students attending a District-operated school will attend classes on campus each day. Florida Virtual School will remain an option for those wanting a non-traditional alternative. 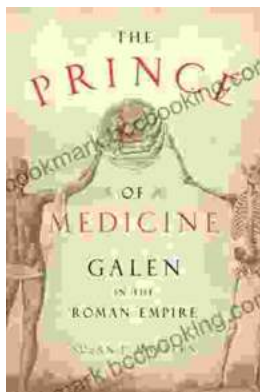
