





1. John Chilembwe (1871-1915)





2. David Livingstone (1813-1873)





3. Harry Johnston (1858-1927)




Harry Johnston was a British colonial administrator who served as the first Commissioner and Consul-General of the British Central Africa Protectorate, which later became Malawi.

4. Levi Mumba (1884-1945)




Levi Mumba was a Malawian politician and activist who served as the first president of the Nyasaland African Congress.

5. Hastings Banda (1898-1997)




Hastings Banda was a Malawian politician who served as the first president of Malawi after independence. He ruled the country for 30 years.

6. Gwanda Chakuamba (1924-2006)





7. Bakili Muluzi (born 1943)





8. Bingu wa Mutharika (1934-2012)





9. Joyce Banda (born 1950)





10. Peter Mutharika (born 1940)




Peter Mutharika was a Malawian politician who served as the sixth president of Malawi.

11. Lazarus Chakwera (born 1955)




Lazarus Chakwera is a Malawian politician who is the current president of Malawi.

12. John Chilembwe, Jr. (born 1947)




John Chilembwe, Jr. is a Malawian politician and the son of John Chilembwe.

13. Patricia Kaliati (born 1958)




Patricia Kaliati is a Malawian politician who has served in various ministerial positions.

Sosten Gwengwe is a Malawian politician who is the current Minister of Finance.


15. Kondwani Nankhumwa (born 1977)


